elevator to the 124th floor observation deck [At The Top] to overlook the modern city and the unique

Afternoon, ride the elevated monorail to visit the so-called "Eighth Wonder of the World" — [Palm								
Island]. It is shaped like a palm tree and composed of various luxury hotels, beach villas, and water								
parks, forming a "sister island" relationship with [The World Islands]. View the famous [Atlantis								
Hotel] from outside. Enter the world-famous seven-star [Burj Al Arab Hotel] for a 90-minute								
immersive tour, allowing visitors to experience its ultra-luxurious interior and learn about its glorious								
history while viewing one of its suites.								
Evening: Join the [Dubai Creek Night Cruise], sailing for about two hours on a traditional Arabian								
wooden dhow to enjoy the colorful night view of both banks and listen to Arabic folk music while								
savoring a special buffet dinner on board. Return to the hotel after the cruise.

Morning: After breakfast, drive past Dubai Free Trade Zone and the [World's Largest Man-Made								
Harbor] Jebel Ali Port, cross the famous Chain Bridge, and head to the capital [Abu Dhabi], a garden								
city in the desert. Enter the [Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque], the largest in the UAE, built in memory of								
the late King Zayed. The mosque is decorated with tens of thousands of precious gems, crystal

chandeliers, and the world's largest handmade carpet. The entire complex is clad in Greek marble, its pure-white appearance solemn and majestic. Then make an exterior photo stop at the eight-star [Emirates Palace Hotel], whose design combines traditional Arabic royalty with Western luxury, exuding a truly regal presence. Lunch features an authentic Arabic buffet.

Afternoon: After lunch, enter the [Presidential Palace] Qasr Al Watan — the national palace of Abu Dhabi and one of the most expensive presidential palaces in the world. It normally hosts foreign dignitaries; President Xi Jinping's 2018 state visit to the UAE was welcomed here. Continue to Saadiyat Island for an exterior photo stop at the [Louvre Abu Dhabi], whose architecture was designed by a Pritzker Prize-winning architect. After sightseeing, return to Dubai.

Morning: After breakfast, head to the UAE's third-largest emirate, [Sharjah]. Exterior view the [Cultural Square] and [Quran Monument], both designed personally by the ruler of Sharjah. See the exterior of [Al Faisal Mosque], donated by the wealthy Faisal family. Visit the Heart of Sharjah – [Al Naboodah House and Heritage Area], a 150-year-old Arab mansion resembling a Chinese courtyard house, built from seashell limestone and coral stone. Inside are furnishings and tools once used by Arab families, illustrating traditional lifestyles. Then explore the Blue Souk [Train Head Handicraft Market], so named because its roof resembles a train engine and personally designed by the Sheikh who studied in the UK. Here you may buy fine gold jewelry, Arabian scarves, tapestries, and other handicrafts, and enjoy bargaining with local shopkeepers.

Afternoon: After lunch, ride a traditional Abras [water taxi] across Dubai Creek to admire the [Iranian Village] and modern architecture on both banks, showing the transition from desert life to modern prosperity through oil wealth. Stop for photos at the [Dubai Frame], a new landmark that vividly separates the old and new city. Enter the [Miracle Garden], Dubai's largest outdoor recreation site and known as the most beautiful garden in the world, built with 45 million flowers forming colorful walls and 4 km of pathways that shine brilliantly under the sun.
